- Residential
 - o Prepare you for real-life experiences outside of treatment
 - o Interrupt and reduce eating disorder behavior
 - o Establish (or re-establish) normalized eating patterns
- Partial Hospitalization
 - o Provides a structured day support for teens and adults of all genders who do not need overnight support.
 - o Group therapy

 - The program runs three mornings a week for 3 hours a day allowing for most people to still work or go to school.
